Understand Your Member Benefits: Websites

This biennium most DKG state organization and chapter websites will be re-certified. Webmasters can find the new *Society Website Certification Request* Form 72, with **new certification standards** on the international website. Click on *Form* in the top gray bar. Next, click on the green folder labeled *Website*. The updated Form 72 includes a checklist to make it easier for webmasters to re-certify websites.

Communications and Publicity Committee members will review sites. When the website is in compliance, the DKG website seal will be sent and the site linked to the international website. Webmasters should post the seal on the bottom of the homepage. If a site is not in compliance, committee members will work with the webmaster to meet the standards. When a site reaches compliance, the certification process can be completed. The committee's goal is to have all websites re-certified before the 2013 regional conferences.

First-time Certification.

Certified websites will be linked from the international site. After sites are certified, state organizations may link chapter sites.
