#### **Smooth Transition**

The 2008-2010 International President and the nominee for 2010-2012 International President, desire a seamless transition into the new biennium. The work of an international committee is finished at the end of a biennium. However, there is usually a period of 2-3 months following the international convention and prior to the first organizational meeting of committees.

In the past, this time of transition created a delay in getting Web sites reviewed and approved, since the contact person on the form was not changed until the first meeting of the international communications committee at which time this decision was made. So, to avoid any delay for reviewing chapter or state organization Web sites, the current international communications committee will continue to be responsible for reviewing and approving Web sites and will continue the dissemination of the *Tip of the Month*, until the newly appointed committee meets and determines its goals and activities for the 2010-2012 biennium.

#### Changes May be Coming

Constitution Revision may occur at the 2010 International Convention. Changes in the criteria for membership, the process for restoring a reserve member to active, reinstating a former member, the number and structure of committees and many other issues will be debated.
